The sum awarded will not exceed €500 per successful applicant, and will be used to help with the extra assistance which may be needed or required at that time and in particular for the buying of a computer, the purchase of books or indeed assistance with the payment of a deposit required to secure good student accommodation.

A suitable undertaking will be required from all recipients concerning how they will use the grant and payment received to further the above objective. Applicants should note the objectives of the trust when making an application. The Trustees will take into account the case made in the application and the grant itself will be paid subject to the acceptance and enrolment of the applicant in a third level or further training facility or programme. Funding may be offered provisionally pending evidence of acceptance on a course or programme. It should be noted that the conditions of the grant are directly related to the objectives of the fund as stated in its purpose.
